KELLER BAND REGISTRATION DAY

Our Keller High School Marching Band Registration Day is on Saturday, August 21st. This day is for parents and students, and we will have a schedule in place for ALL band members (winds, percussion and colorguard) on this day, not just new members.

This is an important day to take care of uniform fittings, portraits in uniform (see below), fall fees, band booster sign-ups, volunteer sign-ups and much, much more! Additionally, there will be a meeting for parents during each time slot. <u>Each student must have at least one parent in attendance at registration.</u>

Please arrive promptly at your scheduled time so that you do not miss any of the announcements.

You will need to allow a couple of hours to complete this process. Your family has two options to pay for fees for Registration Day:

1] Pay online at the KISD Web Store (preferred). (The instructions to use this online service are listed later in this newsletter under the Financial Information section.)

2] Bring your checkbook/debit card, as you will have the opportunity to pay your fees and join band boosters.

If you have more than one child in band, you may bring both of them at the same time. Generally, the earlier time works well in these cases, but either one will work. You do not need to communicate which time that you will be attending. We will take care of you when you arrive.

<u>Uniform Portraits-Registration Day</u> – This will be the only day that portraits will be taken in uniform. Feel free to arrive with hair/makeup already done for this special occasion.

AUGUST CAMP

In order for us to be successful for our first performance, we need to meet before the first day of classes to rehearse. Please go to www.kellerhighband.org, and click the "calendar' on the upper right corner for specifics about each rehearsal day/times.

You will need the following at each rehearsal in addition to your instrument, music, etc.

- ✓ Your own 1-gallon water jug (marked with your name)
- ✓ Bath or beach towel
- ✓ Hat
- ✓ Sunglasses
- ✓ Athletic shorts (no pants or jeans)
- ✓ Light colored t-shirts (no long sleeves)
- ✓ Tennis shoes for running or cross training (no vibrams, 5 finger shoes, boots, sandals or hard-soled shoes are allowed).
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ 3 ring binder with sheet protectors for all music

Students that are not dressed appropriately or do not have the above supplies may be sent home from rehearsal at the directors' discretion. Your safety is our number one concern!!!

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

You have two options to pay for the Keller Band Participation Fees:

- 1] <u>KISD Web Store (preferred</u>). These fees are already listed if you would like to pay early. KISD Web Store link is: https://intouch.kellerisd.net
 - User name= student's 6 digit Keller ISD student ID number
 - Password= student's last name (exactly as they used to enroll in school and it is case sensitive)

Once logged in:

- Under where it says "Who are you shopping for?" click on the student's name
- Under "Shop", click on "Items at Student's School"
- Next to "Categories" click on "Band"
- Select the item(s) you want to purchase and click on "Buy"
- Click on "Checkout" and follow the prompts to complete the checkout process Once checkout is completed, a receipt will automatically appear on the screen.

****Special Note****

Please purchase as many items in one order. There is a \$3 transaction fee per order.

- 2] <u>Pay by check</u>. You can use your checkbook to pay for the items. The items that are purchased through the Keller Band are payable to <u>KHS Band</u>. The Band Boosters take check or credit cards.
 - Keller High School Band Participation Fee Please look closely at your family's scenario for pricing:
 - o 1st wind/percussion student \$375
 - o 2nd KHS wind/percussion/colorguard student \$300
 - School Instrument Rental Fee \$100 This only applies to those students using KISD school instruments. This fee also covers the usage of a marching and concert instrument. You should have already paid this fee in May when you checked out an instrument. If not, please pay this fee as soon as possible.

- Marching Shoes \$42 for new members or replacement pairs. (khsbandgear.com)
- Gloves \$8 (for 2 pair) for brass and woodwind members only (KISD webstore)
- Game Day Meals (optional purchase)- \$100 Planned meals on game day afternoons that are available immediately after school. We strongly urge your family to participate, covering quick turnaround on game days and some contest days. Meal plan for students with special dietary restrictions will be \$120, and are provided by the KHS Band Booster Club.

1-MILE RUN

One of the physical requirements for all marching band members is the completion of one mile (four laps around the track) in 10 minutes. The demands that are asked of today's marching bands are highly rigorous and athletic, and the performers need to be at a certain level of physical fitness to be successful. Begin training now if you have not started!!!

Everyone will attempt the one-mile distance as a part of your PE credit for the class. Suggestions for the summer are to start slowly, walking the distance without stopping at first. Next, see if you can make one lap around the track while timing yourself. Continue timing yourself on a regular basis, gradually adding distance and speed. If you are under the care of a physician and are not able to run, please bring a doctor's note on the first day of camp detailing specific modifications that you are to follow as well as the length of time that you require those modifications.

1st attempt to pass this off will be on Friday, July 30th.

DAILY REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

Once classes begin on August 18th, we will begin our daily after school rehearsal schedule. It will be crucial that you are very aware of practice start and end times. After school practices begin at 4:30 pm. Ending times vary depending on the availability of the practice field. We work to make our schedule consistent, but with the number of activities and special events that we have to plan around, there may be changes. Attendance is vital to what we do. Please schedule tutorials, doctor/dental appointments outside of all rehearsal times.

DRUM CAMP

SAT/ACT TESTING SCHEDULE

Please look at the Keller Indian Band website for the dates of SAT/ACT tests. You will see several that we recommend that do not conflict with band activities. Go to www.indianband.org and scroll down to the Google Calendar at the bottom of the website. If you click through each of the months, the recommended testing dates are listed.

The majority of the band program will be involved in three very important competitions in the fall that coincide with testing dates. Those dates are October 2nd – BOA Dallas Regional (SAT), October 23rd -Duncanville Marching Invitational (ACT) and November 6th – BOA Super Regional in San Antonio (SAT). We have provided opportunities in the schedule for you to take these important exams. Plan and schedule now so you are able to be successful with both important items.

MARCH•A•THON

We will be holding our 19th Annual Marchathon on Saturday, September 11th. All band members perform at this event, which has become a memorable tradition in the Keller community. This is a fundraiser in which the entire band will contribute by collecting donations as we march along the parade route through Keller. We have a great time playing on the parade route and also stopping for scheduled concerts along the way.
