We wanted to share with you some information on what our participation at football games will look like this fall. While we don't have all of the information just yet, we wanted to communicate to you what we have.

We are happy to announce that the KHS Marching Band WILL be participating in all of the home football games this fall! This has taken quite a bit of coordination between KISD officials, the Fine Arts office, and the band staff. We are putting the finishing touches on the details for social distancing and other COVID-19 mitigation policies, and will share those with you in the coming days. To insure that our students are in the best possible situation when it comes to safety, no KISD bands will be participating in regular season away football games this year, including games where we are the "away" team at our KISD stadium.

The dates of our home games are:

October 2nd vs. Denton Braswell

October 15th vs. Dallas Skyline

October 23rd vs. Keller Central (Homecoming)

November 5th vs. Eaton

November 20th vs. Fossil Ridge

One part of the COVID-19 mitigation strategy for football games is a limit on the number of band students that will attend each game. While this number is significant, it is not large enough for every KHS Band member to attend every game. We are currently working on our plan for how our group will be divided up, and will get that information to you next week. Additionally, we are working on some additional public performance opportunities that will involve the entire band, and look forward to sharing those with you soon.
